How to get here



By road from the east

Follow the M4, M50 and A40 to Haverfordwest. Take the A487 to St. Davids. As you enter the village-city, turn left before the Grove Hotel and follow this road for half a mile. The cottages are the last buildings on the right before the sea.

By road from the north

Follow the A487 through Fishguard and to St. Davids. Follow this road through St. Davids, turning left at the T-junction opposite Ystwyth Stores, then right after the Grove Hotel.

Location



Caerfai is an ancient farmstead overlooking the spectacular Pembrokeshire coast, 350 metres from the clean, sandy bathing cove of the same name. Welsh for 'Mai's Fort', Caerfai was named after the Iron Age clifftop camp nearby.

Just 10-minutes' walk away is the village-city of St. Davids with its majestic Norman Cathedral, Bishop's Palace, galleries, shops, restaurants and pubs. Caerfai is also an excellent base for coast walking, with the route from here to Porthclais described as one of the most fascinating sections of the Pembrokeshire coast path.

Caerfai Farm is now a 180-acre organic dairy farm with pastures free of artificial insecticides, herbicides and fungicides. Renewable energy is a primary consideration and solar, geo-thermal, bio-gas and wind power are all used here. During the summer, the farm shop sells organic vegetables, general groceries and award-winning Caerfai Organic Cheeses which are hand-made on the farm. Guests are welcome to watch the cows being milked from a viewing gallery.

The cottages

All four cottages have enclosed gardens away from the present farm buildings. All are heated with night storage heaters with wall heaters in the bathrooms.

The cottages are typically equipped with the following: log burners, televisions, CD players / radios, washing machines, tumble dryers, dishwashers, cookers, microwaves, fridge-freezers, irons, ironing boards, vacuum cleaners, hot water bottles and OS maps.

Cots, high chairs and safety gates are all available on request (cots can be accommodated only in certain bedrooms; please bring your own cot linen and blankets). All our beds are 4 ft 6 ins wide (double) or 3 ft wide (single). Our duvets and pillows have man-made fillings and the beds are made up, ready for your arrival.

The Stable

- Originally the stable which housed the heavy work horses:

 - Living room with exposed trusses and log burner
